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GROUP PROJECTS: OBJECTIVES

To help students in developing skills that are increasingly important in the professional world

- •Break complex tasks into parts and steps
- •Plan and manage time
- •Refine understanding through discussion and explanation
- •Give and receive **feedback** on performance
- Develop stronger communication skills
- Delegate roles and responsibilities
- •Share different perspectives
- Pool knowledge and skills

GROUP PROJECTS: JOURNAL OF ACTIVITIES

- Coordination: divide among members the time for schedules, arrange meetings, meet, correspond, make decisions collectively, integrate contributions.
- Motivation: establish common expectations for each group, increase the individual accountability by reporting the time spent.
