The organizers of the IFToMM World Congress 2023 received 14 potential keynote speech candidates from Technical Committees, Permanent Commissions and Executive Council. After discussing with Executive Council, the General Co-chairs proposed to the Scientific Committee the following four keynote speakers for WC2023:

Professor Kanako Harada (University of Tokyo, JAPAN), Medical Robotics

The final decision is not known yet, but most probably the proposed keynote speakers will be confirmed.

2) Applications of new members

3) 2024 International Tribology Symposium of IFToMM

The 5th International Tribology Symposium of IFToMM (ITS-IFToMM) was planned jointly with the 8th ECOTRIB in Milano in 2021. ECOTRIB has been postponed to 2023 (in Bari, 21-23 June) and TC-Trib decided to plan the 5th ITS-IFToMM in 2024 to avoid the year of the IFToMM World Congress in Japan.

TC-Trib decides that the 5th ITS-IFToMM will be organized in Salerno, Italy, in March 2024.
