### ***Some thoughts about the assessment of deteriorated structures***

Steel corrosion in reinforcement bars is generally regarded as the main source of deterioration in concrete structures and may affect their ultimate as well as their serviceability limit state behavior. The use of stress field models is proposed in the seminar for the assessment of corrosion-damaged reinforced concrete structures. When applying such models, the effect of deterioration must be quantified. The relevant information regarding geometry, material properties and bond may be introduced into the models to establish the residual load bearing capacity of deteriorating RC structures. The uncertainties associated with such models have proved to be acceptable, as observed by comparison with available test results, although deviations of the theoretical results from the actual load bearing capacity of corrosion-damaged members are higher than found in strength models for sound structures.
